INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL HYDRAULIC STOOLS

Congratulations, you have bought a beautiful stool **hand-made in Italy** from top quality materials. Please read the instructions carefully before use to ensure safe and satisfactory operation of this product.



Care and Maintenance

<u>Metal parts:</u>

Remove dust on metal parts with a soft cloth. If necessary, they can be cleaned with a damp cloth. Use glass cleaner or mild soapy water. Do not to use any abrasive cleaner or harsh detergent as this can damage the surfaces. Dry immediately afterwards.

If you spill liquids or food on the metal surface, pay attention to clean and always dry immediately. <u>Fabric, Ecoleather, Real Leather:</u>

Dust and dirt can be removed from the upholstery with a vacuum cleaner (limited suction power) or with a soft brush.

Avoid spilling or dropping crumbs of food with a high fat content on the upholstery.

In case of stains, treat immediately and never use stain-removing products.

Remove as much as possible of the substance causing stain by dabbing with a napkin or kitchen roll. Make a solution of lukewarm (30°) water with a touch of washing liquid and dab (never rub) the stain with a sponge. Then clean again with lukewarm water only.

Never use steam or warm water, as this can fix the stain on the fabric.

Do not use an iron or hairdryer to dry the stain but leave to air-dry.

Do not drag any object across the stool as this can cause permanent damage.

Avoid any direct contact with sunlight and direct heat.

Safety Instructions


Never tilt the stool. Ensure it is always placed firmly on the ground. Do not :

- Use the stool as a ladder
- Climb on the stool
- Stand on the foot-rest of the stool, as this could lead to the stool becoming unbalanced and overturning or may even cause damage to the foot rest.

WARNING :

Sit on the chair to use the weight of the body to tighten the joint on the column and the seat. Please note this is not a permanent fit due to the rise & fall and 360 degree turning action. Always take care and keep feet clear of base when moving / lifting this product.

Do not stand on chair or use as a ladder as this may cause serious injury. Do not use the chair if any part appears damaged, broken or missing.
